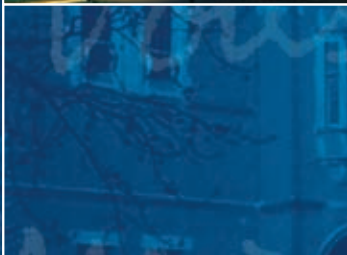

Bequest Program



The story of the growth of Sacré Cœur commenced when the Religious of the Sacred Heart made their first foundation in Victoria in 1888, opening the School with 10 students. It continues today, ensuring Sacred Heart education challenges, encourages and nurtures its students.

The educational needs of today are varied and costly, with increasing demands on schools to expand curriculum and to provide new and improved facilities and equipment.

The Sacré Cœur Foundation is committed to developing strategies to raise much needed additional funding to ensure the independence and ongoing financial viability of the School.

Chaired by Brian McCarthy, the role of the Foundation's Bequest Committee is to encourage all Sacré Cœur supporters to consider leaving bequests to the School in their wills.

Subject to the wishes of a bequestor, bequests to the Foundation will be invested to preserve and build their value and the income generated will assist in financing major building works and renovations, modern technology and equipment. It will also provide library services, scholarships and bursaries for students and professional development of staff.

In this way, every bequest will continue to provide support to the School in the long-term and enable many future generations of students to attend or stay at Sacré Cœur.
